Mathieu is 12 and lives with his mother Agathe, a general practitioner. His father died when Mathieu was only two years old. Since then, every year on the anniversary of his father's death, Mathieu's behaviour becomes abnormally taciturn. Usually

Agathe prefers to not make a big fuss about it and keeps her feet firmly on the ground. This year, however, events take a more dramatic turn. After having heard the story of the Cursed Kings (Les Rois Maudits) at school, Mathieu starts researching his family tree and slowly becomes convinced that he, like the other men in his family, will die young. He has even managed to calculate the exact date of his death and starts taking risks. Agathe, initially helpless before her son's behaviour, finally takes him to see a psychologist. One day, while walking on the sidewalk, Mathieu is knocked over by a car...
